ENHANCED LEARNING CREDITS SCHEME

The scheme provides financial support in the form of a single up-front payment for a maximum of 3 years.

Higher level learning eg. level 3 or higher, can also be claimed up to 10 years after leaving service. **Contact the Veterans Community Hub for further information.**
