The Veterans Work Club

Based at the Veterans Community Hub and open from 9am to 4.00pm the Veterans Work Club can provide a whole range of specialist advice and support with employment, education, funding, CV's and cover letters, volunteering and work placements. In-work support is also available and eligibility for enhanced learning credits.

The Hub can also provide support for welfare, mental health, homelessness, pension's, money advice, coffee mornings, activity afternoons and much more.

Lifeworks

A free support service for ex-service personnel who want to find work, or develop a new career. Help and advice and individual career profiling is available with coping with change, searching and applying for jobs, assistance with interviews.

Cat Zero

16 week Catzero programmes are available for the armed forces communities, which offer a range of motivational activities along with employment skills and the chance to gain up to 6 different qualifications.

Poppy Factory

An employment charity for veterans with physical and mental health conditions, the Poppy Factory can provide support to gain employment and in the workplace.
