You can apply for council housing before you have been discharged from the Armed Forces.

Veterans and some members of the armed forces (and their families) will receive additional priority on the housing list. Hull City Council's Allocations Policy is available online at www.hull.gov.uk for further information.

WHERE TO GO IF ARE SEEKING HELP OR ADVICE?

The Wilson Centre, Hull City Council

The Council's Customer Service Team has 'Armed Forces Champions' who are available to signpost you to the right support to meet your needs.

If you are Homeless or faced with Homelessness

The Housing Options team are also based at The Wilson Centre, and will work with anyone who is homeless or threatened with homelessness.

The service is open from 9.00 - 4.30 daily (open at 10.30 on a Wednesday)

Emergency out of hours

Hull City Council provides an out of hours service for vulnerable homeless people. If you need to contact us ring 01482 300304

Other organisations that provide support specifically for Veterans and their families include:

The Armed Forces Community Hub

Open from 9am to 4.30pm the Hub works in partnership with Hull City Council and a number of Armed Forces Community led organisations

The Hub can provide support for welfare, mental health, homelessness, pension's, money advice, coffee mornings, activity afternoons and much more.

MySpace Housing Solutions

Provide accommodation for vulnerable veterans in need of support.

Hull 4 Heroes

Hull4Heroes provide support and advice to help Veterans and their families transition back into civilian life. Hull 4 Heroes are in the process of developing a 'Veteran Village' on the outskirts of the city which will cater for a wide range of needs.

Haig Housing

Haig Housing has over 1,500 homes throughout the UK and provides rented accommodation to ex-services and their families.

The Veterans Gateway

Veterans' Gateway is made up of a consortium of country-wide organisations and Armed Forces charities.
