There are resources available to help landlords (including those subletting) comply with the new rules, including an online checking aid which landlords can use to guide them through the process and to request a check on anyone who has an outstanding case with the Home Office. Please be advised that this is your responsibility and we must see the proof that this has been done before any consent can be given.
