2. School meals or school transport and travelling expenses, where the	
Member is a parent or guardian of a child in full time education, or is a parent governor of a school, unless it relates particularly to the school which	
the child attends;	
3. An allowance, payment, pension or indemnity given to Members;	
4. Any ceremonial honour given to Members; and	
5. Setting Council Tax or a precept under the Local Government Finance Act 1992.	
Reasons for Decision:	
The decision is made on the basis that without the dispensation the number of p	persons prohibited
by section 31(4) from participating in any particular business would be so gre the body transacting the business as to impede the transaction of the business Prior to the Localism Act 2011 ('the Act'), general exemptions were provided to	at a proportion c of Council.

Prior to the Localism Act 2011 ('the Act'), general exemptions were provided to all Members, by way of statutory instrument with regard to prejudicial interests in any business of the authority where that business related to functions of the authority. The Act does not reproduce these exemptions and as a result, Members will effectively be both breaching their Code of Conduct and also committing an offence, should they take part in a meeting where any of these matters are being discussed and they have a disclosable pecuniary interest in the matter. Where these matters arise it is prudent for a general dispensation be granted to apply to all Members
