What to do before your litter-picking

Equipment available are:

- Litter Pickers
- Hi-Vis
- Collection bags

Items ordered will be delivered to your address.

All group members need to be briefed on Health and Safety before your litter picking to make sure everyone is safe.

What to do during litter picking



Health and Safety

- Wear hi-vis, gloves and use litter equipment at all times
- Only use litter picks, don't use your hands to pick up
- Make sure children are supervised at all times
- Do not litter pick near open water, unstable banks, derelict buildings and busy roads
- Only litter-pick in the day time and not after dark
- Litter pick with others – never alone. Tell someone where you are and let them know when you are home safe.



Collecting litter

- Gain the landowner's permission if you are litter picking on private land
- Only use green branded #LoveHullHateLitter bags
- If you want to recycle during litter picking, use clear bags to collect clean and dry recyclables. Take them home and recycle using your blue bin.
- **Additional blue bins are available on request.**

- Broken glass - hull.gov.uk/street-cleansing

What to do when you are finished litter picking

- Contact the Love Your Street Hull Team to arrange bagged litter collection. Don't forget to tell us how many bags you have ready and exactly where they are left:
- Leave your green branded **#LoveHullHateLitter** bags with your Hull City Council black litter bins
- Clear recycling bags can be left with your blue recycling bin on collection day
