- Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes and amendments or cancellations of proxy votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Guildhall, Kingston upon Hull, HU1 2AA by 5 pm on Wednesday, 31st January 2024.
- 6. New applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Guildhall, Kingston upon Hull, HU1 2AA by 5 pm on Wednesday, 7th February 2024.
- 7. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Guildhall, Kingston upon Hull, HU1 2AA by 5 pm on Thursday, 15th February 2024. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5 pm on Wednesday, 7th February 2024. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5 pm on Wednesday, 7th February 2024
