Street Trading Conditions



- 1. No trading shall take place unless from a properly constructed stationary portable stall, or properly equipped vehicle/trailer specified in the application for consent.
- 2. No flashing lights or bright lights should be attached to vehicles, trailers or stalls.
- 3. Traders must not sound any horns, bells, chimes, loudspeakers etc before 12pm or after 7pm and using any of the above devices should only be conducted in accordance with current legislation.
- 4. Trade of any kind outside, near to, or in the immediate vicinity of a school, college, etc is forbidden.
- 5. The certificate of consent shall be displayed on the stall, vehicle or furniture at all times, and the trader must only sell the commodity, trade on days, between the times, and in the location(s) specified on the consent.
- 6. The trader shall keep the site in a tidy condition and free from nuisance or danger. A suitable lidded receptacle for refuse shall be provided by the trader.
- 7. The stall, vehicle and furniture shall be removed from the site at the end of each day's trading.
- 8. All refuse shall be removed by the trader from and/or near the consented site/area at the end of each day's trading.
- 9. Any stall or vehicle used for cooking food, (other than chestnuts), shall have a suitable fire extinguisher available, and the trader shall comply with the relevant food hygiene regulations.
- 10. The trader shall not cause or permit any unnecessary obstruction on the highway.
- 11. Consents will not apply during periods when road(s) are closed for special events.
- 12. Traders will move their stall or vehicle when required to do so by a Police Officer or an Authorised Officer of the Council.
- 13. Quarterly fees must be paid in full before the current quarter expires. Failing to do so may result in revocation.
- 14. The identification plate provided by the Council shall be displayed clearly on the inside or outside the vehicle. The identification plate remains the property of the Council.
- 15. Identification badges, provided by the Council, must be worn (or produced on demand by an authorised officer) by all persons involved with the running of the stall, trailer or vehicle.
- 16. Consents are not transferable to any other person.
