**Notice of adoption of the Affordable Housing
Supplementary Planning Document (SPD15)**

On the 20th September 2019 Kingston upon Hull City Council adopted the Affordable Housing Supplementary Planning Document (SPD15). The adopted SPD provides guidance on Policy 5 Type and Mix of Housing, Parts (2), (3) and (4) Affordable Housing of the Hull Local Plan 2016 to 2032. This SPD has been prepared to guide applicants through the planning process to ensure that Hull's physical environment is not harmed by a planning proposal and that any significant adverse impacts of a development scheme are addressed at the most appropriate stage of the planning process.
