New one way signage agreed for Moorhouse Road

The police approached the council to see if it was possible to add to existing signage at the entrance to Moorhouse Road because they had received a number of reports about vehicles going the wrong way. Highways recommended a number of additional signs and road markings to draw attention to the fact that a one-way system is in operation. The improvements have been agreed and funded from the local ward budget. Two additional white arrow signs have already been installed, and the additional road markings will be done soon.

New bench

A number of residents contacted the Ward Councillors about whether a bench could be installed at one of the bus stops on Wold Road. We contacted JCDecaux, who manage bus stops within the city, and they arranged for a bench to be added earlier this year.



Improvements to verges on County Road South

Plans have now been finalised for improvements to the verges along County Road South. The improvements are designed to prevent damage from vehicle overrun and parked vehicles that have prompted complaints by residents in recent years. The plans will also allow passing places for HGVs and other lorries to pass each other safely and not mount the kerb and drive along the verge. It will also provide additional car parking spaces. Full details of the plans are overleaf. If you have any comments or questions, please contact us. Work has not started yet, as there are a couple of final hurdles to jump before an order for the works can be submitted.

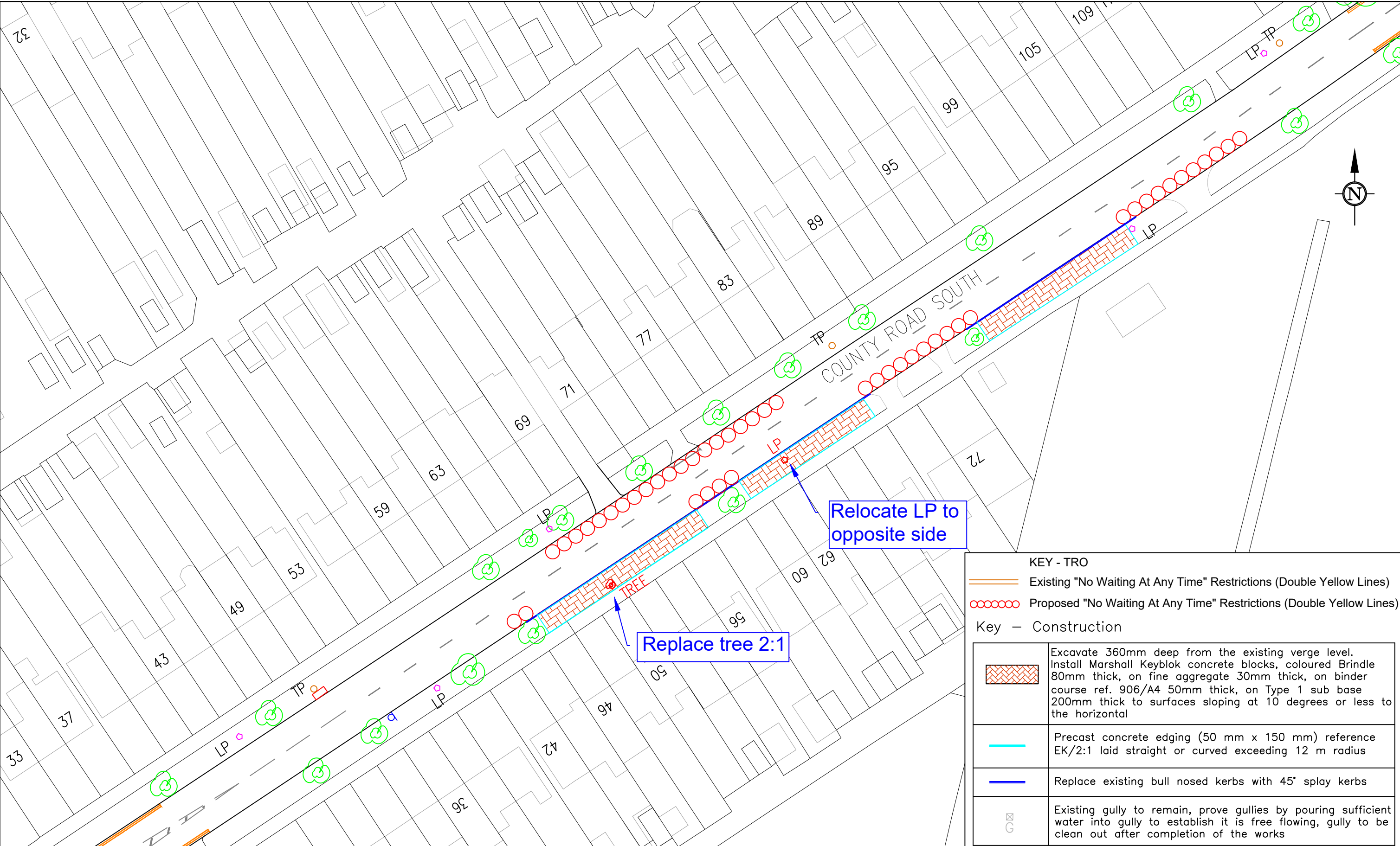
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Main Features:
Creates 13 off-road parking spaces in block paved verge along southeast side.
Requires relocation of one lamp column to other side and removal of one tree & planting of 2 trees.
TRO required for prohibition of waiting - removes 4 parking spaces from the northwest side.
Need signs and markings to indicate extent of verge parking areas.
Scheme creates 9 extra net parking spaces and provides passing place for HGVs to prevent verge over-run.
