Bring out your rubbish days

In 2025 the ward funded five bring out your rubbish days spread across the ward. The total collection for all events was 190.12 tonnes of waste and 152 fridge freezers.

Warm spaces

We have five warm spaces in the Hessle Road Area which have received funding, these are:

- Groundworks – West Dock Street
- Hessle Road Network – Massey Street
- The Volcan Centre – Heron Street
- The Fishing Heritage Centre – Hessle Road
- Maurice Rawling Community Centre – Bean Street.



Massey Street Green Space

To help prevent vehicles illegally entering the playing field, preventative measures have been installed funded by the Crime Prevention Fund and the ward budget. The kerb at St. Georges Road has been raised, the fencing has been secured and concrete blocks installed along the perimeter of the fence on Massey Street. Parks and Gardens have also installed football posts to make the field a more useable space. We hope this will make a difference for all to enjoy this green space in future months.



Traffic Calming measures – Selby Street and Glasgow Street

Working in partnership with Highways, traffic calming measures have been installed on Selby Street and Glasgow street, slow signs and extra double yellow lines.

Later this year electric slow signs are planned to be fitted on Woodcock Street.



Redbourne Street

After concerns from residents regarding speeding scooters and bikes. The ward has funded metal railings that have been installed in the passageway on Redbourne Street.



Summer Bike Library

In the summer months working with one of our partners R-evolution, the ward funded bikes, helmets, lights and locks to three local primary schools. In total 90 bikes and equipment were supplied to the children at Adelaid Primary, Newington Academy and Chilton Primary.

This year the Bean Street Park has received new equipment, this includes a new safe surface, the old equipment has been painted and cleaned up. This really is a great space for families to enjoy.

Located next to the park is the Maurice Rawling Community Centre. They are running lots of new activities including darts and bingo, they are a registered Warm Space and also provide meals and free food on a Friday.
