## Living with Water Privacy Notice - Water butt offer

Residents are invited to apply for a free water butt through the Living with Water partnership. We collect personal information to assess the eligibility of a resident to receive a free water butt and ensure that it can be installed appropriately.

We would also like to contact residents in the future to ask you whether the water butt has been useful, but you can opt out of this if you do not wish to be contacted after installation.

We process information about residents who are applying for water butts.

Information we may include -

- address, including post code
- details of water butt installation
- names and contact information

The information is obtained only from completed water butt applications.

If you agree that we can contact you in the future to discuss how useful the water butt has been your name and contact details will be retained for up to 1 year. If you do not wish to be contacted again your personal details will be retained for up to 6 months after the date of installation.

The address of the water butt installation will be retained for up to 5 years as we will prioritise the installation of new butts at properties which have not received one in the past.

We process personal information to deliver our public tasks in accordance with Article 6 1 (e) of the General Data Protection Regulation.
