

**PART F.**
**1. Fees**

The fees associated with implementing temporary traffic restrictions are dependent on the type of restriction put in place and the section of the Road Traffic Act used to implement the restriction. Fees are reviewed annually in July for distribution on 1<sup>st</sup> August.

14 (1)	Minimum fee £1,250 plus VAT.	<p>This is the standard traffic order to use on all planned works on the highway. This can be for a maximum of 18 months for restrictions affecting the road/carriageway. This period includes any emergency TTROs processed for the same works/locations. A maximum initial period of 6 months is allowed for public right of ways. Again, this period includes any emergency TTROs processed for the same work/locations. The maximum period will only be allowed if the Council is satisfied that it is necessary to facilitate the works.</p> <p>Costs are dependent on several factors including the cost to advertise the legal road closure. Any additional charges will be invoiced to the applicant.</p>	12 weeks from the time of application and supporting documentation
16 (A)	Minimum fee £500 plus VAT.	This order is used to restrict or prohibit traffic on the road due to an event that is held on the highway. This may be subject to a cost reduction, depending on the type of event.	12 weeks from the time of application and supporting documentation
TPCA	Minimum fee £500 plus VAT.	This order is used to restrict or prohibit traffic on the road due to a special event/parade that is held on the highway. This can be for a maximum of 3 days for restrictions affecting the carriageway. This may be subject to a cost reduction.	12 weeks from the time of application and supporting documentation
