## **Sarah - Learner**

I heard about Springboard YEI through my Family Practitioner at the Parks Children's Centre. I had some initial meetings with my Key Worker who went through what I can expect by being on Springboard YEI. He told me about the various different training courses and other support on offer. I wanted to get qualifications in Maths and Health and Social Care. My Key Worker gave me a number of options to choose from.

I am getting help from CERT on a one to one basis with my Maths. My Key Worker is always on hand to answer any questions or give me support. I am gaining knowledge working towards my level 1 in Maths and I will then do my level 2. I feel more confident about meeting new people and also going to places.

My Key Worker gives me help and support and is easy to get on with. Paying for travel is good as I wouldn't be able to get to Kenworthy House or other providers without it.



## **Alex - Key Worker**

I first met Sarah who was a referral from the Children's Centre. Sarah expressed an interest in wanting to go into Childcare or Health and Social Care but was unsure of the steps needed.

I explained how the YEI can help her achieve her training and employment goals by offering various options. This enabled Sarah to make her own decisions and empowered her to move forward.

Sarah also got help with childcare costs whilst on the YEI as this was a barrier affecting her learning journey in the past. Travel costs to and from the training centre was also a concern for Sarah but this barrier has been broken down by the YEI covering this.

Sarah is a focused individual who needed help and support to enable her to do what she wanted to do. She is also doing her Functional Skills, meeting new people and making friends as she goes along the learner journey.
